**ORDINANCE**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:**

**SECTION 1.** Chapter 2-36 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by inserting a new Section 2-36-305, as follows:

**2-36-305 Buildings with a truss system – Data collection required.**

The division marshal in charge of the bureau of fire prevention or the division marshal's designee shall develop, manage and maintain a database of all buildings, located within the city, that are known to contain truss construction systems. On a monthly basis, the division marshal shall transmit such data to the office of emergency management and communications, which shall upload the data to its computer-aided dispatch system and provide such information to fire companies upon dispatch.

**SECTION 2.** This ordinance shall take full force and effect six months after its passage and publication


