BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:


Section 1:

The ordinance passed by the City Council of the City of Chicago for **YOSHI'S CAFE** on **04/19/2017**, and printed upon page **48094** of the Journal of Proceedings of the City of Chicago is here by Amended by deleting the words "area #1 shall be sixty (60) feet in length and twelve point eight three (12.83) feet in width; total of seven hundred sixty nine point eight (769.8) square feet; seating capacity 56; Compensation \$1,154.70" and inserting in their place the words "area #1 shall be eighty-five (85) feet in length and fourteen point three (14.3) feet in width and area #2 shall be twenty-three point seven five (23.75) feet in length and four point five (4.5) feet in width along N Halsted St; total of one thousand three hundred twenty-two point three eight (1,322.38) square feet; seating capacity: 72; Compensation: \$,1983.56"
