## ORDINANCE 314 WEST SUPERIOR LIMITED PARTNERSHIP Acct No 88350 - 2 Permit No. 1134853

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago

SECTION 1 Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to 314 WEST SUPERIOR LIMITED PARTNERSHIP, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use, as now constructed, one (1) Exterior mount(s) projecting over the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 314 W. Superior St

Said Exterior mount(s) at W- SUPERIOR measure(s):

One (1) at two (2) feet in length, and two point five (2.5) feet in width for a total of five (5) square feet. Existing exterior mount is approximately seventeen (17) feet above grade level

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Transportation (Division of Project Development).

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.


The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1134853 herein granted the sum of four hundred (\$400 00) per annum in advance

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way

Authority herein given and granted for a period of five (5) years from and after 07/09/2018.
