**WHEREAS**, A longtime resident of Glencoe, the Honorable Jeremiah D. McAuliffe was the loving and devoted husband of Doris; and

**WHEREAS**, The Honorable Jeremiah D. McAuliffe was the much-adored father of Jane, Mary, and The Honorable Jeremiah and the grandfather of one to whom he imparted many of the fine and noble qualities which he possessed in abundance; and

**WHEREAS**, The Honorable Jeremiah D. McAuliffe was active in the village affairs of Glencoe, serving as a Village Trustee and as a member of the Glencoe Plan Commission; and

**WHEREAS**, The Honorable Jeremiah D. McAuliffe served as a Senior Partner in the law firm of Pattishall, McAuliffe, Newbury, Hilliard & Geraldson, specializing in trademark and copyright law with an emphasis on international rights; and


