RESOLUTION MEMORIALIZING THE LIFE OF DAVID WILLIS HILL, SR.

WHEREAS, God in His infinite wisdom and judgment has called to his eternal reward, David Willis Hill, Sr., beloved citizen and friend, Sunday, August 4, 2013 at the age of 83; and

WHEREAS, The Honorable Carrie M. Austin, Alderman of the 34th Ward has informed this august body of his passing; and

WHEREAS, Born August 17, 1929 in Faunsdale, Alabama, David was the loving son of Waverly and Viola (Green) Hill. David was the fifth of nine children born to the loving and caring parents. He and his four sisters, Bettie, Fannie, Bessie and Viola along with his four brothers, Waverly, William Bryant, Edward and Johnnie brought laughter and joy into the Hill Family home. He confessed his faith in Christ at an early age at First Baptist Church and participated joyously with the congregation; and

He retired in 1987 to spend more quality time with his family members and his many friends. Mr. David Willis Hill, Sr. was an advocate member of the 34th Ward Regular Democratic Organization; and

WHEREAS, David Willis Hill, Sr., a loving and devoted husband, father, grandfather, brother, friend and neighbor will be deeply missed, but the memory of his character, intelligence and compassion will live on in those who knew and loved him; and

WHEREAS, David Willis Hill, Sr. leaves to celebrate his life and cherish his memory his wife, Joan; daughter, the Honorable Pamela E. Hill Veal; son, Dr. David W.
