BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. That the Chicago Zoning Ordinance be amended by changing all of the current C1-1 Neighborhood Commercial District symbols and indications as shown on Map Number 1-L in the area bounded by:

a line 225 feet north of and parallel to West Kinzie Street; North Laramie Avenue; West Kinzie Street; the public alley next west of and parallel to North Laramie Avenue

to those of C1-2 Neighborhood Commercial District.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and due publication.

As required by Section 17-13-0107 of the Municipal Code of the City of Chicago, please be informed that on or about May 21, 2014, the undersigned, on behalf of By The Hand Club For Kids (the "Applicant"), intends to file an application to rezone the property located at 400-420 N. Laramie Avenue and 5200-5214 W. Kinzie Street, Chicago, Illinois (the "Subject Property") from the C1-1 Neighborhood Commercial District to the C1-2 Neighborhood Commercial District.

The Subject Property is currently improved with a two-story vacant building and a single story auto mechanic shop. The purpose of the rezoning is to allow for construction of a new school building and accessory surface parking. 
