ORDINANCE BELLY Q Acct. No. 19446 - 1 Permit No. 1107221

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to BELLY Q, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to construct, install, maintain and use two (2) Awning(s) projecting over the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 1400 W. Randolph St..

Said Awning(s) at W. Randolph Street measure(s):

Two (2) at twenty-two point two five (22.25) feet in length, and five point seven five (5.75) feet in width for a total of two hundred fifty-five point eight (255.88) square feet.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Zoning Department - Signs.

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1107221 herein granted the sum of one hundred (\$100.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.

Authority herein given and granted for a period of five (5) years from and after Date of Passage.




Awnings

3 7700 series retractable awnings with front valance, weatherquard hood with manual operation on the right side, installed on the S/F of the building. Frame made of extruded aluminum with a bronze finish. Using Sunbrella material #4608 Black, with a hemmed straight style valance design. Excluding any lettering/signage.
