WHEREAS, It is with great sadness that members of this Chamber learned of the death of William G. Naegele on March 6, 2014, at the age of 63; and


WHEREAS, The City Council has been informed of his passing by The Honorable Margaret Laurino, Alderman of the 39<sup>th</sup> Ward; and
