*Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:*

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to BILL'S BAR & BURGER, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to construct, install, maintain and use four (4) Awning(s) projecting over the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 30 E. Hubbard St..

Said Awning(s) at Hubbard measure(s):

Two (2) at ten point two five (10.25) feet in length, and six point five eight (6.58) feet in width for a total of one hundred thirty-four point eight nine (134.89) square feet.

One (1) at ten point two five (10.25) feet in length, and four (4) feet in width for a total of forty-one (41) square feet

One (1) at thirty-one point nine one (31.91) feet in length, and ten point nine one (10.91) feet in width for a total of three hundred forty-eight point one four (348.14) square feet.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Zoning Department - Signs.

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1132223 herein granted the sum of fifty (\$50.00) per annum in advance.

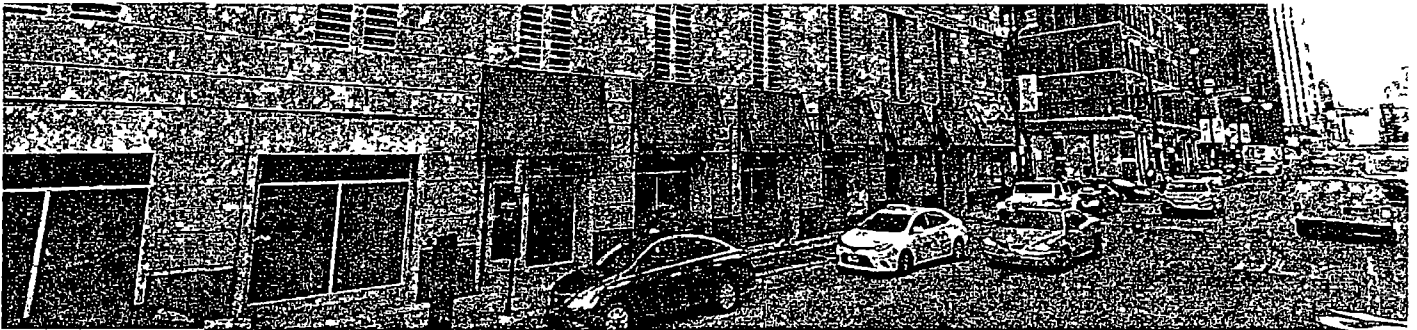
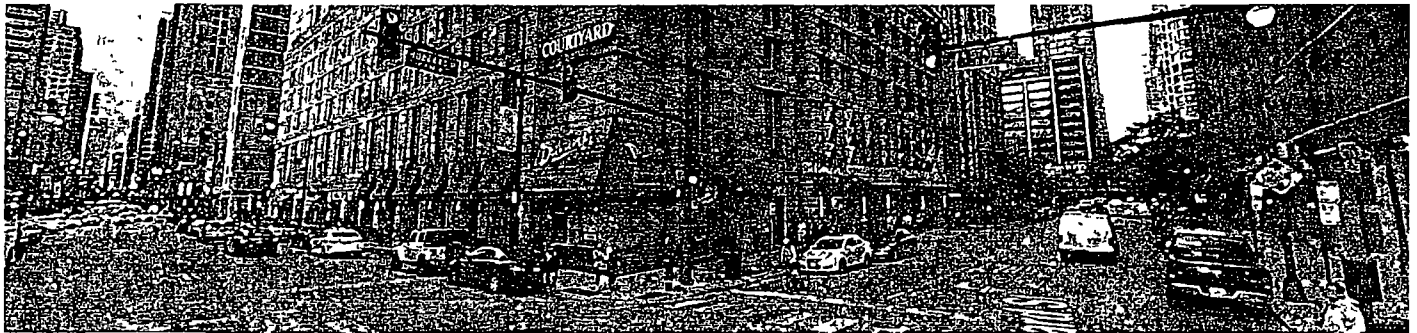
A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.
