*Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:*

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to FRESH MARKET PLACE, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use, as now constructed, six (6) Awning(s) projecting over the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 2600 N. Central Ave..

Said Awning(s) at N CENTRAL AVE measure(s):

One (1) at fifteen point two five (15.25) feet in length, and two point three three (2.33) feet in width for a total of thirty-five point five three (35.53) square feet.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Zoning Department - Signs.

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1114691 herein granted the sum of one hundred seventy-five (\$175.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

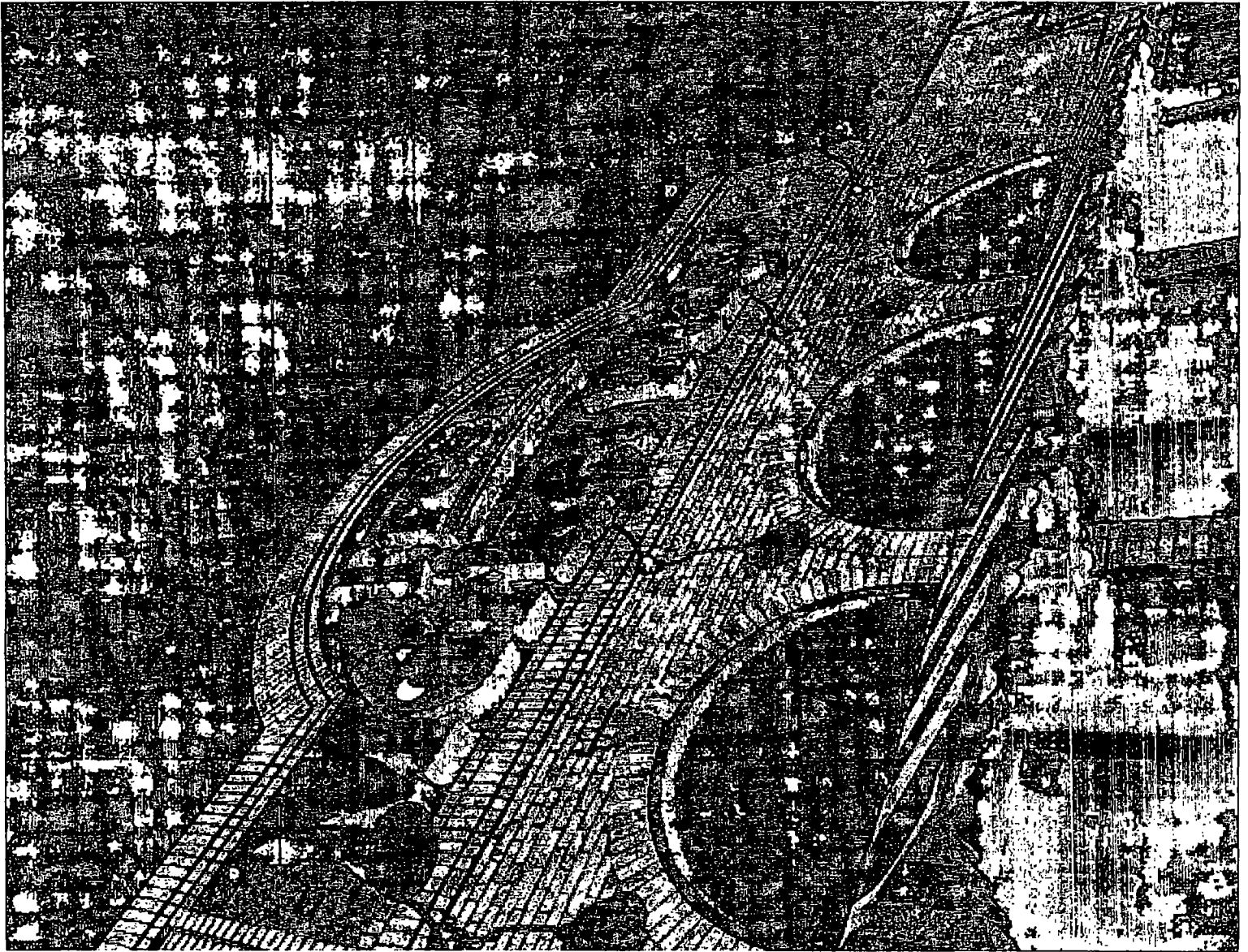
The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.

Authority herein given and granted for a period of five (5) years from and after 04/22/2014.

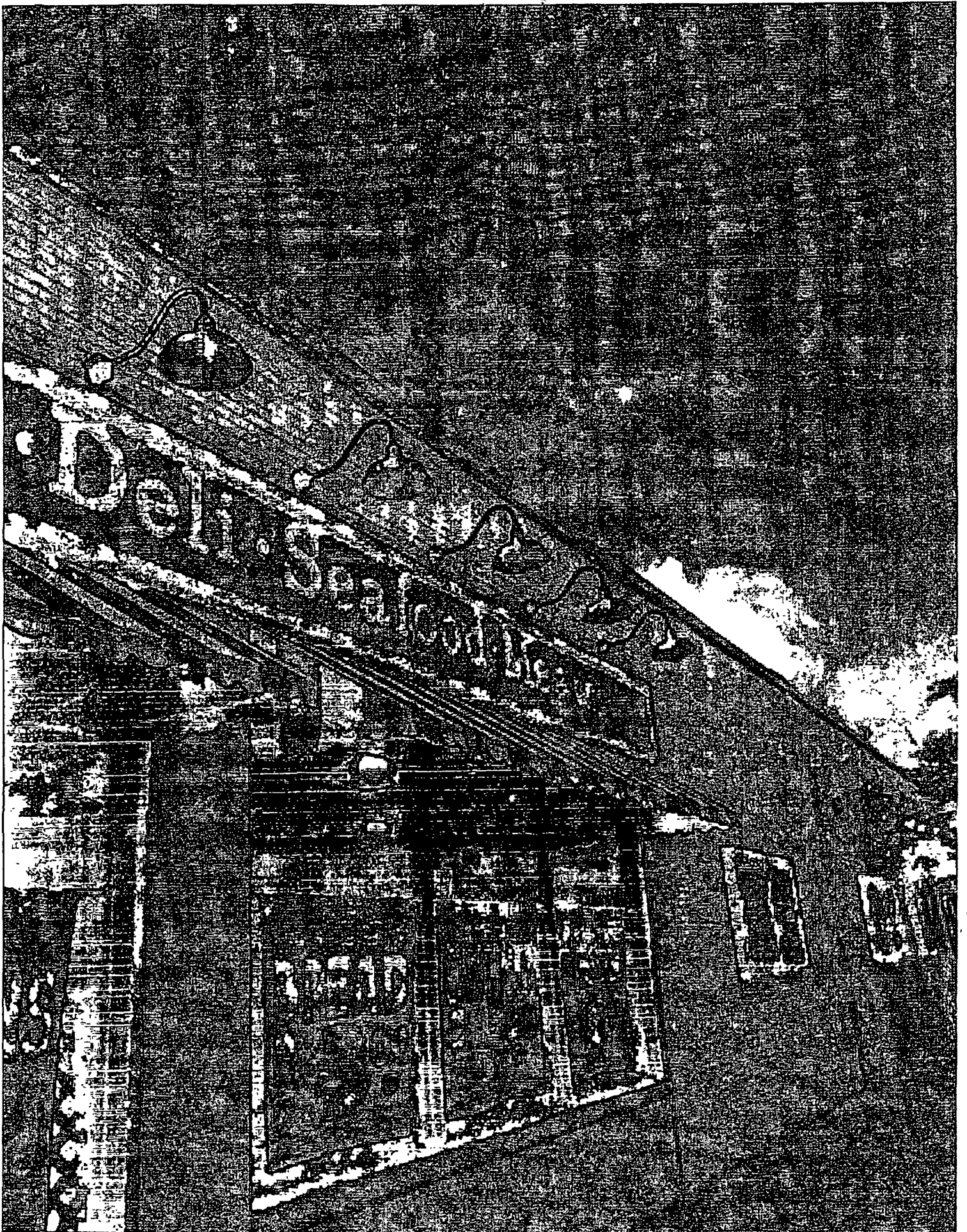
