WHEREAS, The hard work, dedication and sacrifice of Theodore "Ted" Pincus serve as an example to all; and

WHEREAS, His love of life and ability to live it to the fullest endeared Theodore "Ted" Pincus to his family members, friends and all who knew him, and enabled him to enrich their lives in ways they will never forget; and

WHEREAS, Theodore "Ted" Pincus will be dearly missed and fondly remembered by his many relatives, friends, and colleagues; and
