

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

Section 1. Pursuant to Section 10-20-430 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Commissioner of Transportation is hereby authorized and directed to exempt Seeds of Joy Enterprise, Chicago, Illinois 60613, from the provisions requiring barriers as a prerequisite to prohibit alley ingress and egress to parking facilities for 4425 N. Magnolia Avenue.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force upon its passage and publication.
