**WHEREAS,** The talent and vision of Harold Ramis will influence future generations of artists for many years to come; and

**WHEREAS,** The legacy and dedication of Harold Ramis serve as an example to all; and

**WHEREAS,** His love of life and ability to live it to the fullest endeared Harold Ramis to his family members, friends and all who knew him, and enabled him to enrich their lives in ways they will never forget; and

**WHEREAS,** Harold Ramis will be dearly missed and fondly remembered by his many relatives, friends and admirers; and

**WHEREAS,** To his beloved family, Harold Ramis imparts a legacy of faithfulness, service and dignity; now, therefore
