**WHEREAS**, Helen C. Doria was the first Executive Director of Millennium Park and a force for culture and the performing arts in Chicago; and


**WHEREAS**, In 2008 Helen C. Doria founded Helen Doria Consulting, a company which served corporate clients and artistic organizations; and
