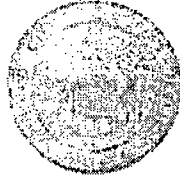

The Community Commission for Public Safety and Accountability submitted candidates to me for consideration for two current Police Board vacancies. Pursuant to Section 2-80-080(c) of the Municipal Code of Chicago, upon receipt of these recommendations, I have 30 days by which to identify candidates for Council approval. The two candidates I select for appointment as members of the Police Board are:

Andreas G. Safakas for a term effective immediately and expiring August 10, 2027, to succeed Andrea Zopp, who has resigned; and

Ajalteria Carr-Favors for a term effective immediately and expiring August 10, 2027, to succeed Steve Flores, who has resigned.

Both candidates have agreed to serve upon approval of their appointment by the City Council.
