

**TRAFFIC LANE - TOW/AWAY ZONE**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:**

**SECTION 1. Pursuant to Title 9, Chapter 64, of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the following locations are hereby designated as traffic lane – Tow-Away Zones, between the limits and during the times specified, standing or parking of any vehicle shall be considered a definite hazard to the normal movement of traffic:**

**WARD            TOW AWAY ZONES:**

40                2745-2800 W. Foster Avenue (south side) from a point 90 feet east of N. California Avenue to a point 238 feet east thereof; No Parking No Stopping No Standing, Anytime, Tow Zone -- (13-00071872) [O2012-8492]

**WARD            AMEND TOW AWAY:**

23                S. Oak Park Avenue; Amend No Parking Tow Zone by striking; No Parking on S. Oak Park Avenue (east side) from Archer Avenue to the first alley north thereof [O2013-9184]

**SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force here in after its passage and publication.**
