INTERNATIONAL BANK OF CHICAGO

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to INTERNATIONAL BANK OF CHICAGO, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use, as now constructed, two (2) Door Swing(s) on the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 217 W. Cermak Rd..

Said Door Swing(s) at W. Cermak Road measure(s):

Two (2) at three (3) feet in length, and point one seven (.17) feet in width for a total of one point zero two (1.02) square feet.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Transportation (Division of Project Development).

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1118514 herein granted the sum of one hundred fifty (\$150.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

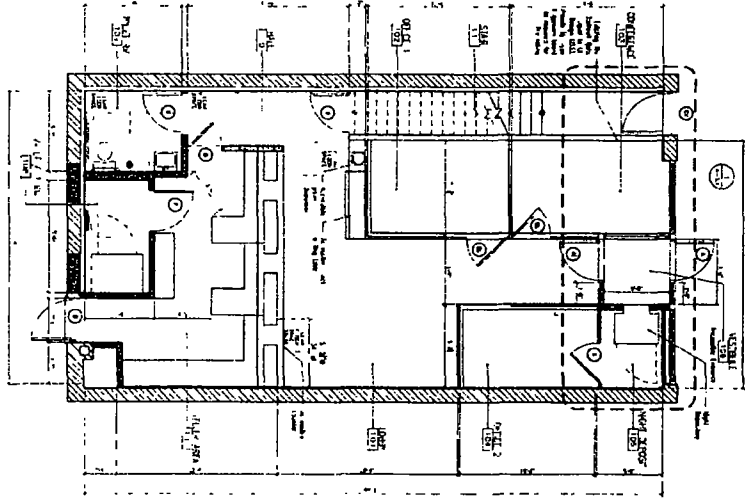
The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.

Authority herein given and granted for a period of five (5) years from and after Date of Passage.

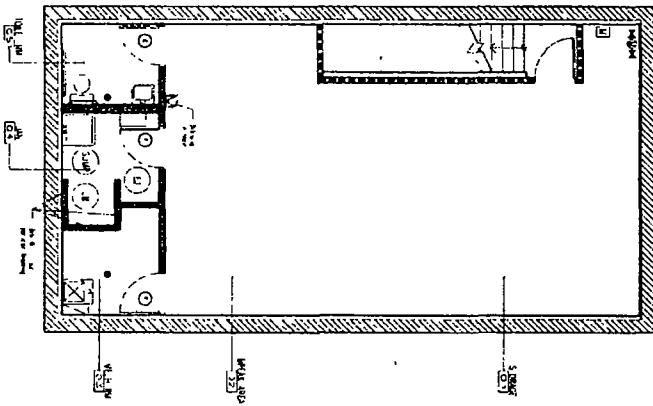

GENERAL NOTES

1. All work shall be in accordance with the specifications and drawings.
2. The contractor shall be responsible for obtaining all necessary permits.
3. The contractor shall be responsible for protecting all existing work.
4. The contractor shall be responsible for maintaining access to all areas.
5. The contractor shall be responsible for cleaning up after the work.

FINISH NOTES

1. All walls shall be finished with 1/2" gypsum board.
2. All floors shall be finished with 1/2" concrete.
3. All ceilings shall be finished with 5/8" acoustic tile.
4. All doors shall be finished with 1 3/4" solid wood.
5. All windows shall be finished with 1/2" aluminum.

WALL TYPES

1. 1/2" gypsum board on metal lath.
2. 1/2" gypsum board on concrete.
3. 1/2" gypsum board on masonry.
4. 1/2" gypsum board on steel deck.
5. 1/2" gypsum board on wood joist.

DOOR TYPES

1. 1 3/4" solid wood.
2. 1 3/4" solid wood with glass.
3. 1 3/4" solid wood with metal.
4. 1 3/4" solid wood with plastic.
5. 1 3/4" solid wood with fabric.
