LOYOLA UNIVERSITY OF CHICAGO

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to LOYOLA UNIVERSITY OF CHICAGO, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to construct, install, maintain and use eight (8) Awning(s) projecting over the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 1209 W. Albion Ave..

Said Awning(s) at N. Sheridan Road measure(s):

Five (5) at nineteen point one seven (19.17) feet in length, and three point five eight (3.58) feet in width for a total of three hundred forty-three point one four (343.14) square feet.

One (1) at twenty-five point eight three (25.83) feet in length, and three point five eight (3.58) feet in width for a total of ninety-two point four seven (92.47) square feet.

Said Awning(s) at W. Albion Avenue measure(s):

One (1) at twenty-six point eight three (26.83) feet in length, and three point five eight (3.58) feet in width for a total of ninety-six point zero five (96.05) square feet.

One (1) at thirteen point one seven (13.17) feet in length, and three point five eight (3.58) feet in width for a total of forty-seven point one five (47.15) square feet.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Zoning Department - Signs.

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1119506 herein granted the sum of one hundred seventy-five (\$175.00) per annum in advance.


A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.

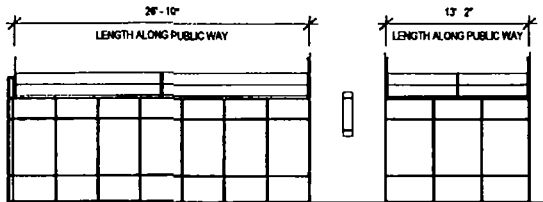

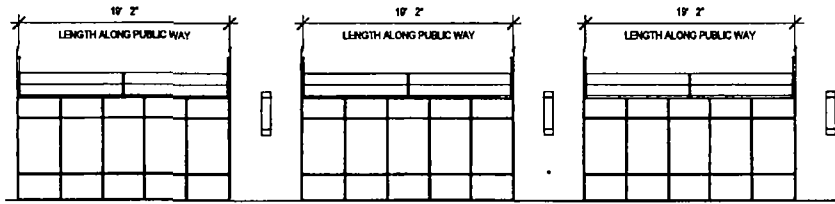

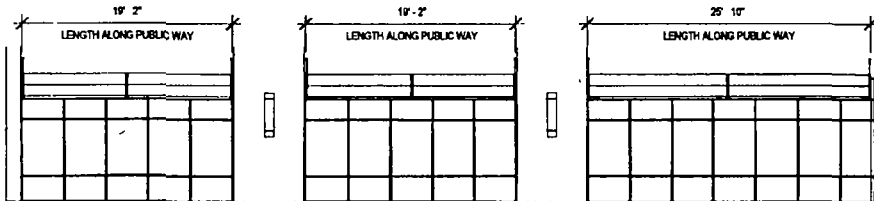

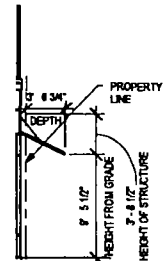
① ALBION CANOPY ELEVATION
