WHEREAS, Over its' thirteen year history, Ride for AIDS Chicago has raised over \$4 million for HIV/AIDS services; and,


WHEREAS, Ride for AIDS Chicago will be held during the weekend of July 9 and 10, 2016; and,


WHEREAS, TPAN, the organization producing the Ride, has been serving the HIV/AIDS community in Chicago for more than 28 years; now therefore,






