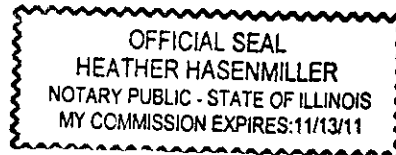

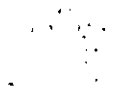

The changed zoning will reflect the actual uses in the building. The building will continue to operate as an mixed use four (4) story building with five (5) existing retail units and the one (1) vacant to be a proposed retail unit on the ground floor with a Sheridan entrance and thirty-seven (37) existing residential apartments on the 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th floors with a Lunt entrance, with no parking.
