**WHEREAS**, The role of the Moderator of the Curia is to work with archdiocesan staff to support the Archbishop in his roles of teaching, sanctifying and governing the faithful as well as supporting relationships with parishes, schools, social service agencies and ministry initiatives; and

**WHEREAS**, The Reverend Clete Kiley is currently a Senior Fellow at the Institute for Policy Research and Catholic Studies at the Catholic University of America in Washington, D.C.; and

**WHEREAS**, The Reverend Clete Kiley is the Director for Immigration Policy for the UNITE HERE International Union and is a member of the steering committee for the United States Catholic Bishops' Justice for Immigrants Initiative; and

**WHEREAS**, The Reverend Clete Kiley previously served as President and Chief Executive Officer of the Faith and Politics Institute for the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops; and

**WHEREAS**, The Reverend Clete Kiley was the Director for the Secretariat for Priestly Life and Ministry and was Special Assistant to the National Review Board and the Committee for the Protection of Children and Young People; and


**WHEREAS**, Earlier in his ministry, the Reverend Clete Kiley was a pastor, administrator and member of the College of Consultors; and
