WHEREAS, Alma Fitzpatrick was an active member in the Christian Family Movement and the Rosary Society; and

WHEREAS, The hard work, sacrifice and dedication of Alma Fitzpatrick serve as an example to all; and

WHEREAS, Alma Fitzpatrick was an individual of great integrity and goodness who wil

l be dearly missed and fondly remembered by her many relatives, friends and admirers; and
