**WHEREAS,** The Chicago City Council has been informed of his passing by Alderman Edward M. Burke; and

**WHEREAS,** The Honorable John Y. McCollister was the loving husband of Betty and the late Nanette; and

**WHEREAS,** The Honorable John Y. McCollister was the much-adored father of John, Steve and Bruce to whom he imparted many of the fine and noble qualities that he possessed in abundance; and

**WHEREAS,** A native of Iowa City, Iowa, the Honorable John Y. McCollister graduated from the University of Iowa and joined the United States Navy during World War II; and

**WHEREAS,** A widely respected business and civic leader, the Honorable John Y. McCollister was the President of McCollister & Co. from 1960 to 1971 and from 1979 to 1986; and

**WHEREAS,** The Honorable John Y. McCollister ably served for three terms as Congressman from Nebraska's 2<sup>nd</sup> District from 1971 to 1979; and

**WHEREAS,** The hard work, sacrifice and dedication of the Honorable John Y. McCollister serve as an example to all; and

**WHEREAS,** The Honorable John Y. McCollister will be dearly missed and fondly remembered by his many relatives, friends and admirers; and

**WHEREAS,** To his beloved family, the Honorable John Y. McCollister imparts a legacy of faithfulness, service and dignity; now, therefore
