***WHEREAS***, An athlete dedicated to his gymnastics training, Charlie Manley worked hard to overcome the obstacles placed in his path by disability; and


***WHEREAS***, Officials from the Special Olympics, an organization to which the Manley family is extremely dedicated, will remember Charlie Manley for his determination and grit; and
