**Title:** Amendment of Section 4-60-022 of Municipal Code to disallow additional alcoholic liquor licenses on portion(s) of N Franklin St and W Illinois St (subsection 42.6)

**ORDINANCE**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Council finds that the areas described in this ordinance are adversely affected by the over-concentration of businesses licensed to sell alcoholic liquor within and near the areas.

**SECTION 2.** Section 4-60-022 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by inserting the underscored language as a new subsection 4-60-022 (42.6), as follows:

**4-60-022 Restrictions On Additional Licenses.**

Subject to the provisions of subsection 4-60-021(c), no additional license shall be issued for the sale of alcoholic liquor, for consumption on the premises within the following areas:

*(Omitted text is unaffected by this ordinance)*

(42.6) Within the area described as follows: beginning at the intersection of North Franklin Street and West Illinois Street thence easterly on West Illinois Street to North Wabash Avenue; thence south on North Wabash Avenue to the north bank of the Chicago River; thence westerly on the north bank of the Chicago River to North Wells Street; thence north on North Wells Street to West Kinzie Street; thence westerly on West Kinzie Street to North Franklin Street; thence northerly on North Franklin Street to the intersection of West Illinois Street and North Franklin Street.

*(Omitted text is unaffected by this ordinance)*

**SECTION 3.** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication.
