WHEREAS, The Chicago City Council has been informed of his passing by Alderman Edward M. Burke; and

WHEREAS, A native of Omaha, Nebraska, Bob Boozer was the loving and devoted husband of Ella; and

WHEREAS, A professional basketball player, Bob Boozer was a member of the original Chicago Bulls; and

WHEREAS, Bob Boozer was drafted by the Chicago Bulls in 1966 and spent three years with the team that included the 1968 All-Star game appearance; and

WHEREAS, Bob Boozer played with six teams over eleven seasons, averaging 14.8 points and 8.1 rebounds per game, and won one NBA Championship with the Milwaukee Bucks; and


WHEREAS, A two-time All-American with Kansas State, Bob Boozer was a gold-medal Olympian at the 1960 Summer Games; and
