

**SINGLE DIRECTION**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:**

**SECTION 1. Pursuant to Title 9, Chapter 64, Section 010 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the operator of a vehicle shall operate such vehicle only in the Direction Specified below on the public ways between the limits indicated:**

<b>WARD</b>	<b>AMEND SINGLE DIRECTION:</b>
15	East and Westbound Alley bounded by West 47th Street, West 47th Place, South Campbell Avenue and South Western Avenue; Single Direction - Westerly [O2016-2938]
18	West 85th Place; Amend Ordinance Passed 08/30/2000, journal page 39811, which reads: West 85th Place from South Hamlin Avenue to South Lawndale Avenue; Single Direction - Easterly, by Striking: South Lawndale Avenue and inserting in lieu thereof: South Central Park Avenue -- (15-06676034) [O2015-8321]

**SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force here in after its passage and publication.**
