UNIVERSITY OF CHICAGO

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to **UNIVERSITY OF CHICAGO**, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to construct, install, maintain and use **three (3) Pipes** beneath the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as **917-33 E. 57th St.**. Said pipes shall be described as follows:

- One (1) sixteen (16) inch steam pipe with a twenty-eight (28) inch casing.
- One (1) eight (8) inch pumped condensate pipe with a sixteen (16) inch casing.
- One (1) three (3) inch compressed air pipe.

All three (3) pipes shall be located under the public way in a one hundred forty (140) feet in length and six (6) feet in width trench. Said trench shall run under and along 917-933 East 57th Street. Trench shall be a maximum of twelve (12) feet in depth.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Transportation (Office of Underground Coordination) and Department of Water Management.

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.


The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1099220 herein granted the sum of one thousand two hundred (\$1,200.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

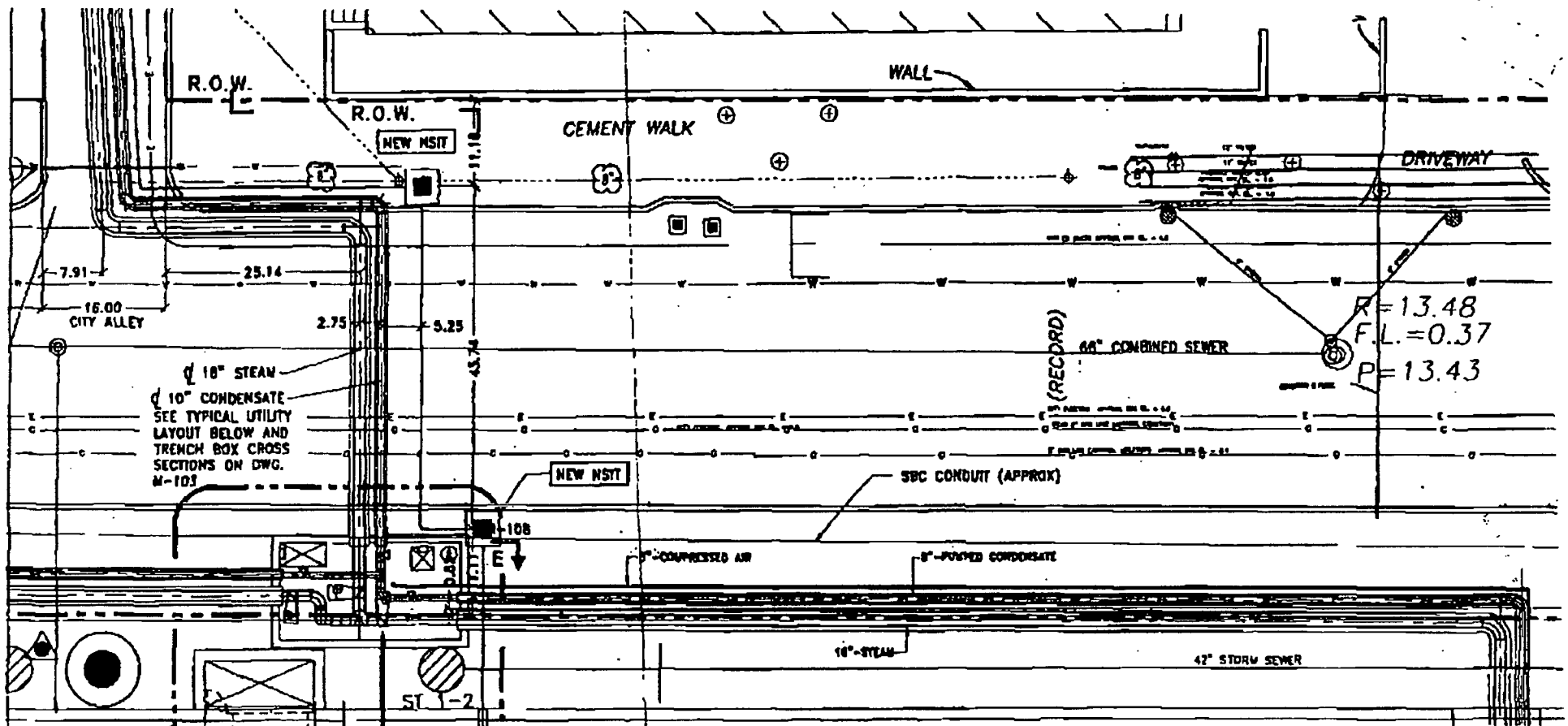
The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.

Authority herein given and granted for a period of five (5) years from and after 10/04/2011.

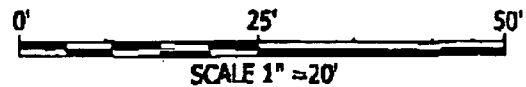
