**WHEREAS**, The Chicago City Council would like to congratulate Dr. Therese Scanlan on her Inauguration as President of Resurrection University; and

**WHEREAS**, The Chicago City Council has been informed of this event by Alderman Edward M. Burke; and

**WHEREAS**, Resurrection University is home to the College of Nursing that offers undergraduate and graduate degrees and the College of Allied Health that offers undergraduate degrees in Health Information Management and Radiography; and

**WHEREAS**, Dr. Therese Scanlan earned her PhD in Higher Education and Organizational Change from Benedictine University, her master's degree in Public Administration from the University of Illinois at Chicago, and her bachelor of arts in Mathematics from St. Xavier University; and

**WHEREAS**, Dr. Therese Scanlan has held significant positions throughout the University's history, including Chief Operating Officer and Chief Financial Officer and led numerous governance, legal, construction and financial initiatives through the school's enormous period of growth; and
