WHEREAS, The City Council has been informed of her passing by The Honorable Margaret Laurino, Alderman of the 39<sup>th</sup> Ward; and

WHEREAS, The beloved wife of the late Anthony; loving mother of Maureen (the late Tony Keane), Eileen (Fred) Millard, Sheila, Noreen, and Kevin (Elaine); dear "Gramma Norah" of Connor and Sam Millard, Tyler and Dylan Brennan; treasured aunt, grand-aunt and friend of many.
