WHEREAS, The Chicago City Council has been informed of her passing by Alderman Edward M. Burke; and

WHEREAS, A native of Chicago, Deanna Brody was the loving and devoted wife for forty-five years of Alan; and

WHEREAS, Deanna Brody was the much-adored mother of Jacob, Joseph, Daniel, and the late Mark, and the beloved grandmother of four; and

WHEREAS, Known as "Dee" to her family and friends, Deanna Brody served as an Aldermanic Aide for three aldermen in Chicago's 43rd Ward; and

WHEREAS, Deanna Brody was appointed by former Chicago Mayor Richard M. Daley to serve as Ward Superintendent of Streets and Sanitation in the 43rd Ward; and

WHEREAS, Deanna Brody advocated for the protection of the state of Israel, lending her support to the Friends of the Israel Defense Forces (FIDF); and

WHEREAS, Deanna Brody was a valued member of the fourth Presbyterian Church, and will be remembered as a woman who spread joy and laughter among all who were fortunate enough to call her a friend; and

WHEREAS, To her beloved family, Deanna Brody imparts a legacy of faithfulness, service and dignity; now, therefore
