WHEREAS, A widely admired member of the religious community, the Reverend Robert L. Tuzik is a Special Assistant to Cardinal Francis George; and

WHEREAS, The Reverend Robert L. Tuzik has worked with the International Commission on English in the Liturgy (ICEL), the Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments in Rome, the Vox Clara Subcommittee of CDWDS, and the Chicago Office for Divine Worship; and

WHEREAS, The Reverend Robert L. Tuzik has published four books and more than seventy articles; and

WHEREAS, The Reverend Robert L. Tuzik holds an AB in literature from Loyola University, a Master of Divinity degree from St. Mary of the Lake Seminary and a Master of Arts degree and Ph.D in liturgical studies from the University of Notre Dame; and

WHEREAS, The Reverend Robert L. Tuzik is a resident of Notre Dame de Chicago where he celebrates Mass and participates in special parish celebrations; and

WHEREAS, The holiness, sacrifice and faithfulness of the Reverend Robert L. Tuzik serve as an example to all; now, therefore
