*Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:*

Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to COBRA LOUNGE upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance, to maintain and use a portion of the public right of way for a sidewalk cafe adjacent to its premises located at 235 N. Ashland Ave.. Said sidewalk cafe area #1 shall be fourteen point five (14.5) feet in length and seven point four two (7.42) feet in width, area #2 shall be thirty-six point four two (36.42) feet in length and nine (9) feet in width, area #3 shall be thirty-eight point two five (38.25) feet in length and six point four two (6.42) feet in width for a total of six hundred eighty point nine four (680.94) square feet and shall allow six (6) feet of clear space from the face of the curb/building line along N. Ashland Avenue, W. Fulton. The compensation for said space and the days and hours of operation for the sidewalk cafe shall be as follows:

Monday through Friday 11:00 a.m. to 12:00 midnight. Saturday and Sunday 12:00p.m. to 12:00 midnight.  
Compensation: \$749.03  
SEATING CAPACITY: 32

Sidewalk Cafe Permit and approved plan must be posted at all times.

This grant of privilege #1128330 for a sidewalk cafe shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-800 through 10-28-885 of the Municipal Code of Chicago and the directions of the Commissioner of Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection, the Commissioner of Streets and Sanitation, and the Commissioner of Transportation.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.

Authority for the above named privilege is herein given and granted from and after March 1, 2017 through and including December 1, 2017.
