THAI ROOM RESTAURANT INC.

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to THAI ROOM RESTAURANT INC., upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use, as now constructed, six (6) Planter(s) on the public right-of-way for beautification purposes adjacent to its premises known as 4022 N. Western Ave..

Said Planter(s) at W. Cuyler Avenue measure(s):

One (1) at nine (9) feet in length, and three point seven (3.7) feet in width for a total of thirty-three point three (33.3) square feet.

One (1) at eight point one (8.1) feet in length, and three point nine (3.9) feet in width for a total of thirty-one point five nine (31.59) square feet.

Said Planter(s) at N. Western Avenue measure(s):

One (1) at six (6) feet in length, and three point one two (3.12) feet in width for a total of eighteen point seven two (18.72) square feet.

One (1) at five point one one (5.11) feet in length, and three point one one (3.11) feet in width for a total of fifteen point eight nine (15.89) square feet.

One (1) at three point nine (3.9) feet in length, and three point four (3.4) feet in width for a total of thirteen point two six (13.26) square feet.

Said Planter(s) at W. Cuyler measure(s):

One (1) at two point eight (2.8) feet in length, and three point six (3.6) feet in width for a total of ten point zero eight (10.08) square feet.

Grantee must allow the required clear and unobstructed space for pedestrian passage at all times per rules and regulations approved by the Department of Transportation.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Planning and Development and Department of Transportation (Division of Project Development).

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1125202 herein granted the sum of zero (\$0.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.

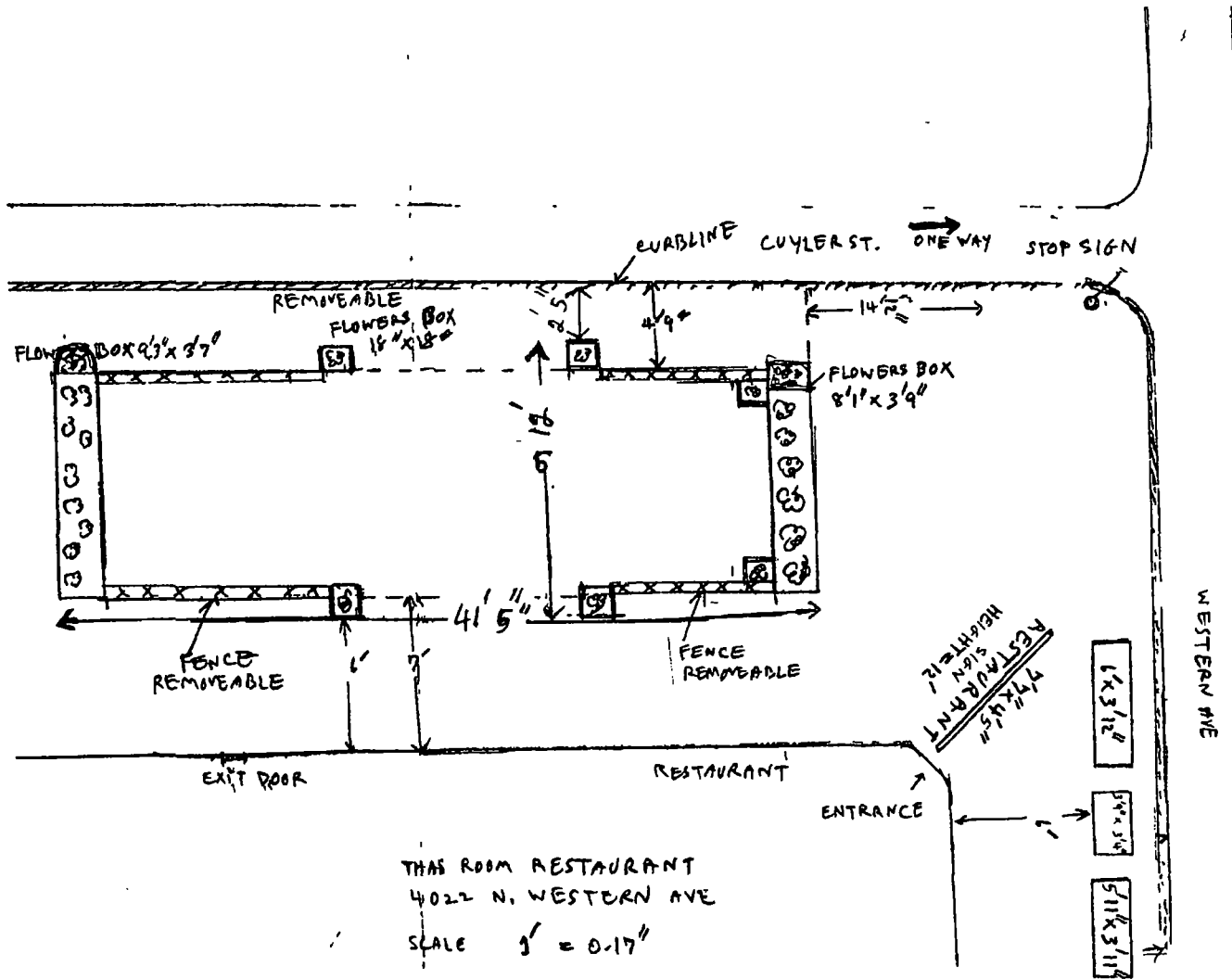
