LAVAZZA CAFE

*Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:*

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to LAVAZZA CAFE, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use, as now constructed, one (1) Awning(s) projecting over the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 162 E. Ohio St..

Said Awning(s) at E. Ohio Street measure(s):

One (1) at twelve point five (12.5) feet in length, and two point zero eight (2.08) feet in width for a total of twenty-six (26) square feet.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Zoning Department - Signs.

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.


The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1107840 herein granted the sum of fifty (\$50.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.

Authority herein given and granted for a period of five (5) years from and after 06/11/2013.

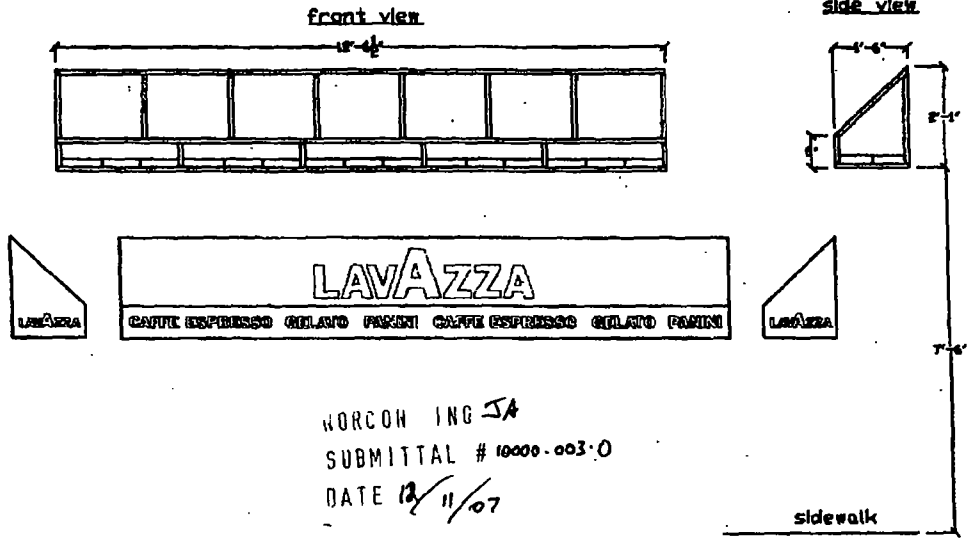

- 1 Traditional style stationary awning with end wings a stationary valance manufactured complete and installed on the building. Frame made of 1" sq and 1/2" rd. welded galvanized steel tubing with welds ground, primed and then all painted black. Awning mounted to aluminum store front with #14 lag screws. Fabric attached by the lace-on method, using Sunbrella material #4678, marine blue.
- Lettering to be white applied vinyl on valance area 8 3/4" h and 12" h on roof area.
