Title: Amendment of Municipal Code Sections 9-64-110 and 9-100-020 by increasing fines for parking or standing vehicles alongside property parked vehicles within Central Business District

ORDINANCE

SECTION 1. Section 9-64-110 of the Chicago Municipal Code is hereby amended by inserting the language underscored, as follows:

9-64-110 Parking prohibited – Roadways, sidewalks, bridges and similar locations.

It shall be unlawful to stand or park any vehicle in any of the following places:

(a) On the roadway side of any vehicle stopped or parked at the edge or curb of a street;

(1) Notwithstanding the above section, the fine shall be tripled for parking or standing a vehicle on the roadway side of any vehicle stopped or parked at the edge or curb of a street in the Central Business District, as defined by section 9-4-010.

(omitted portions are unaffected by this ordinance)

SECTION 2. Section 9-100-020 of the Chicago Municipal Code is hereby amended by inserting the language underscored, as follows:


(a) The violation of any provision of the traffic code prohibiting or restricting vehicular standing or parking, or establishing a compliance, automated speed enforcement system, or automated traffic law enforcement system violation, shall be a civil offense punishable by fine, and no criminal penalty, or civil sanction other than that prescribed in the traffic code, shall be imposed.

(b) The fines listed below shall be imposed for a violation of the following sections of the traffic code:

9-64-110(a)	\$100.00
<u>9-64-110(a)(1)</u>	<u>\$300.00</u>

(omitted portions are unaffected by this ordinance)

SECTION 3. This ordinance is effective upon passage and publication.
