## **ORDINANCE**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Chicago is a home rule unit of government under Article VII, Section 6(a) of the 1970 Constitution of the State of Illinois, and as such may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; now, therefore,

### **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:**

**SECTION 1.** Pursuant to Section 9-64-090(f) of the Code, the following address ranges are designated as buffer zones for a residential parking permit zone (Zone 1145). The residents living in the following address ranges, on both sides of the indicated streets, are eligible to acquire a permit to park in the adjacent residential parking permit zone (Zone 1145), as a result of insufficient available parking caused by that adjacent zone:

1841 to 1910 S. Calumet Avenue  
300 to 326 E. 18<sup>th</sup> Street  
320 E. 21<sup>st</sup> Street

**SECTION 2.** This ordinance will be in full force and effect upon passage and publication.
