## Resolution Honoring Eric Dockery as Principal of the Dewey Academy of Fine Arts

WHEREAS, Eric Dockery received his undergraduate degree in Business and Marketing from Cornell University and a graduate degree in Special Education from Northwestern University; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Dockery has been working for Chicago Public Schools in various capacities for over 12 years; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Dockery has served as the Principal at the Dewey Academy of Fine Arts since February, 2010: and

WHEREAS, Mr. Dockery has worked closely with the Third Ward office to address vacant buildings around Dewey as well as to establish a school garden that will be used for educational and community purposes; and

WHEREAS, It is Mr. Dockery's desire to build a state-of-the-art science lab for Dewey that will not only serve the students, but be the pride of the community as well; and

WHEREAS, The Children's Research Triangle unanimously voted for Mr. Dockery to receive their annual "Heroes of Our Hearts" award for his commitment to serving at-risk youth; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Dockery has worked with the Children's Research Triangle to bring therapeutic services to students who would have otherwise not had access to them; and

WHEREAS, The Dewey Academy of Fine Arts has a student population that is almost entirely low-income; and

WHEREAS, A survey issued to parents whose children attend Dewey showed that parental satisfaction with the school's environment is strong; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, That we the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Chicago gathered this 14<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2011, do hereby acknowledge the important contributions Eric Dockery has made as an educator, particularly towards serving at-risk children; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That a suitable copy of this resolution be presented to Mr. Dockery.
