*Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:*

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to BENJYEHUDA upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use, as now constructed, one (1) Awning with Lettering or Graphics(s) projecting over the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 500 W MADISON ST.

Said Awning with Lettering or Graphics(s) at N. Canal Street measure(s):

One (1) at twenty-seven point one seven (27.17) feet in length and Zero (0) feet in width for a total of twenty-seven point one seven (27.17) square feet.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Zoning Department - Signs.

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.


The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #BACP1595705 herein granted the sum of fifty-two point one seven (\$52.17) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

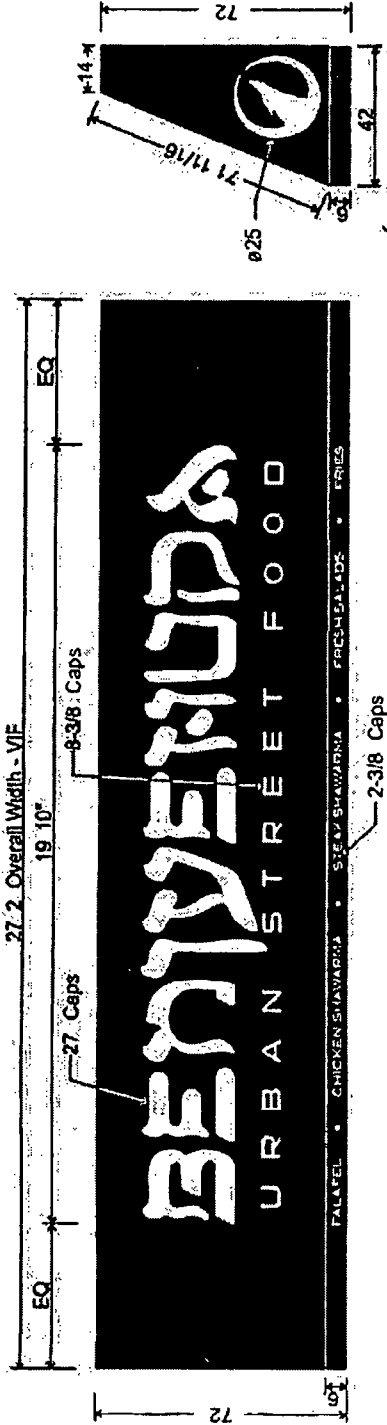
The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.

**Non-Illuminated Modified Shed Style Awning**

3/8" = 1'

Aluminum framed shed style awning with flat top, top reinforced with additional aluminum sheeting for settling and standing water/snow  
Black Sunbrella fabric material, staple attached to framing with black trim

Non-illuminated, exposed framing from underneath

Fabricated with returns to wrap 16' 10" frontage bump out, return back to wall - VIF

Framing attached to building facade with z-clips and to metal mullions  
Secured with sheet-metal tek screws to frame and mullions
