Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to Pockets, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to construct, install, maintain and use two (2) Awning(s) projecting over the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 2101 W. Touhy Ave..

Said Awning(s) at Touhy measure(s):

One (1) at thirty-four (34) feet in length, and five (5) feet in width for a total of one hundred seventy (170) square feet.

Said Awning(s) at Ridge measure(s):

One (1) at thirty-one point six seven (31.67) feet in length, and five (5) feet in width for a total of one hundred fifty-eight point three five (158.35) square feet.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Zoning Department - Signs.

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.


The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1118486 herein granted the sum of one hundred fifteen dollars and sixty-seven cents (\$115.67) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

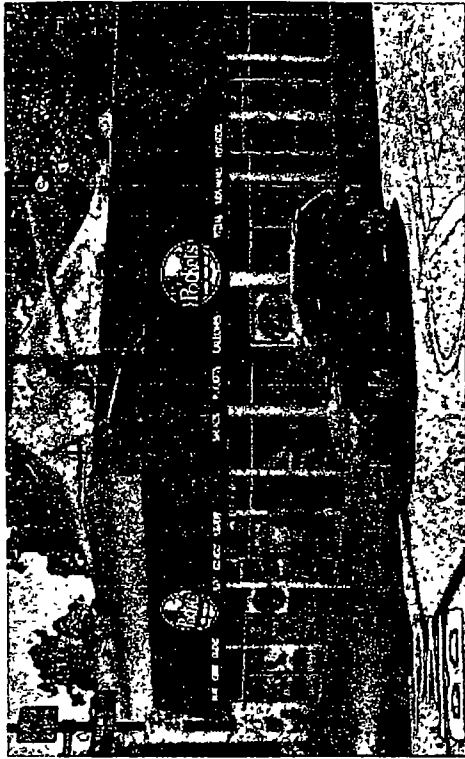
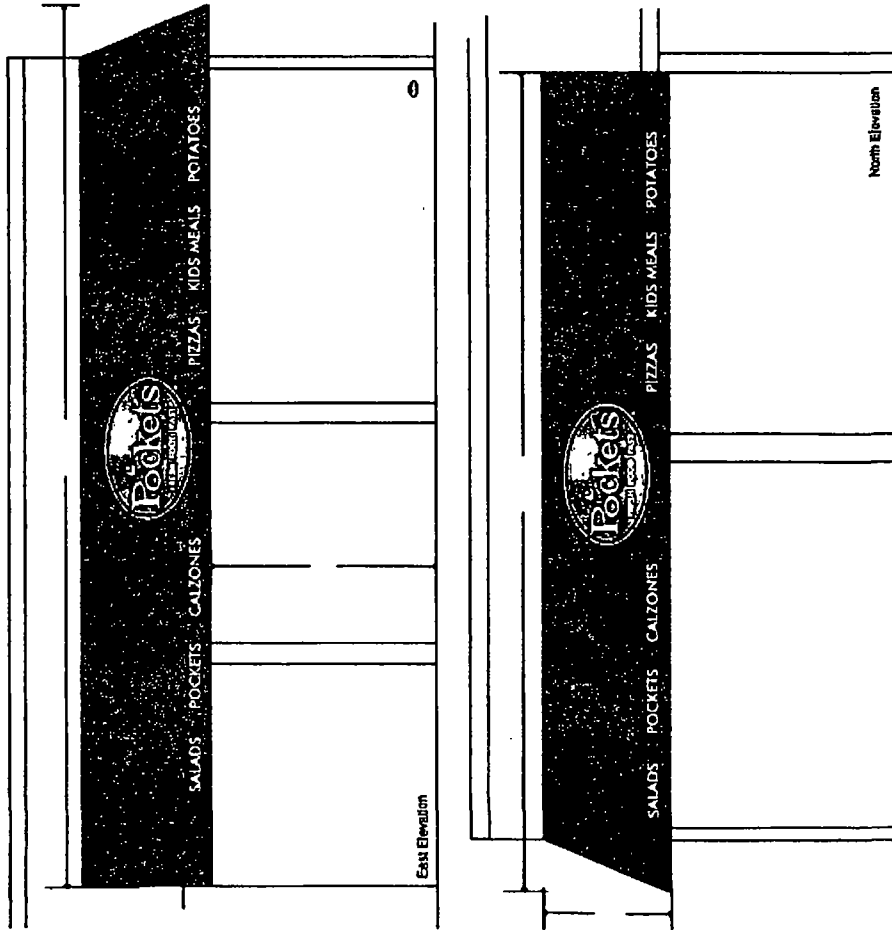
