#### **ORDINANCE**

#### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, is hereby amended by changing all of the RS3 Residential Single - Unit (Detached house) District symbols and indications as shown on Map No. 14-I in the area bounded by

A line 261 feet South of and parallel to West 59<sup>th</sup> Street; the alley next East of and parallel to South California Avenue; a line 291 feet South of and parallel to West 59<sup>th</sup> Street; and South California Avenue.

to those of a RT4 Residential Two-Flat, Townhouse and Multi-Unit District.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and due publication.
