BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1 Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended by changing all of RS 3 Residential Single Unit (Detached House) District symbols and indications as shown on Map No. 1-H in the area bounded by:


