The Special Meeting is for the following purposes and no other purpose whatsoever:

- To receive, as the Committee of the Whole, reports from David Brown, Chicago Police Department Superintendent, regarding the Chicago Police Department's policies and efforts to tamper the soaring violence impacting all Chicago communities this summer; and,
- To receive, as the Committee of the Whole, reports from Rosa Escareno, Chicago Park District General Superintendent and Chief Executive Officer, regarding the Chicago Park District's policies and efforts to include and make available all programs for Chicago's youth throughout all seventy-seven communities this summer; and,
- To receive, as the Committee of the Whole, reports from Pedro Martinez, Chicago Public Schools Chief Executive Officer, regarding the Chicago Public Schools' policies and efforts that create safe neighborhood epicenters throughout Chicago.

We understand the fears, concerns and demands for sustainable solutions addressing the violence and criminality that is increasing exponentially throughout our diverse communities. It is our hope that this public forum, in the absence of customary hearings, will address the people's concerns.
