ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning
Ordinance is hereby amended by changing all of the M3-3 Heavy Industry District
symbols as shown on Map No. 26-B

in the area bounded by:

A line 160.00 feet north of and parallel to East 106th street;

A line 333.00 feet east of and parallel to South Torrence avenue;

East 106th street and;

A line 268.0 feet east of and parallel to South Torrence avenue.

To those of a C2-3 Motor Vehicle-Related Commercial District

SECTION 2. This Ordinance takes effect after its passage and due publication.

Narrative and Plans For a Type 1 Zoning Amendment 2664 East 106th Street From M3-3 to C2-3

Project Description: The subject property is improved with a 2-story mixed-use building. He is requesting a change from an M3-3 district to an C2-3 district.

The applicant needs the zoning change to meet the use requirements of the district to allow the establishment of a banquet hall and private event space on the 1st floor and one apartment on the 2nd floor of the existing 1 and 2 story building with on site 16 parking spaces provided.

- A. Proposed land use: Banquet hall and private event space and one apartment/Lot size: 10,400 sq. ft.
- B. The project's floor area ratio: FAR = 2.0
- C. The project's density lot are per dwelling unit = 10,400 square feet.
- D. The amount of off-street parking: 16 parking spaces.
- E. Setbacks:
 - a. Front: 10'-9"

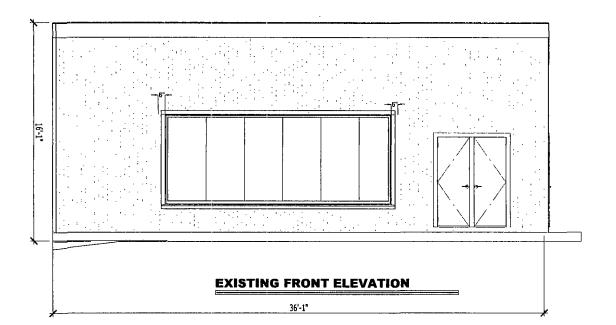

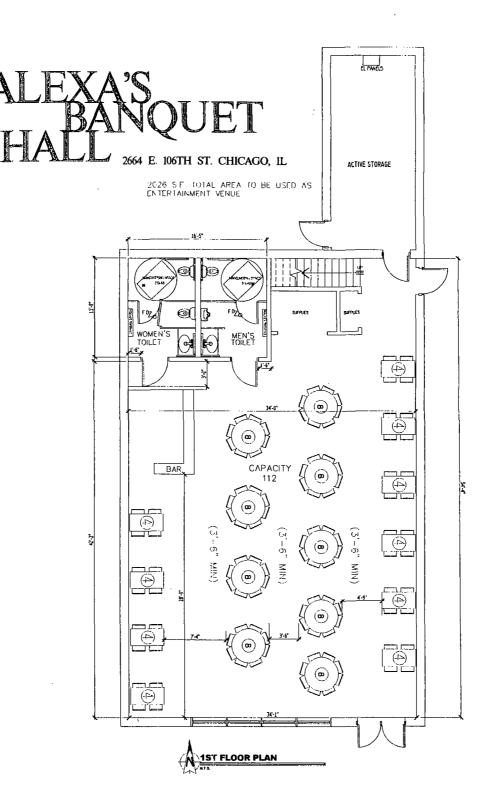

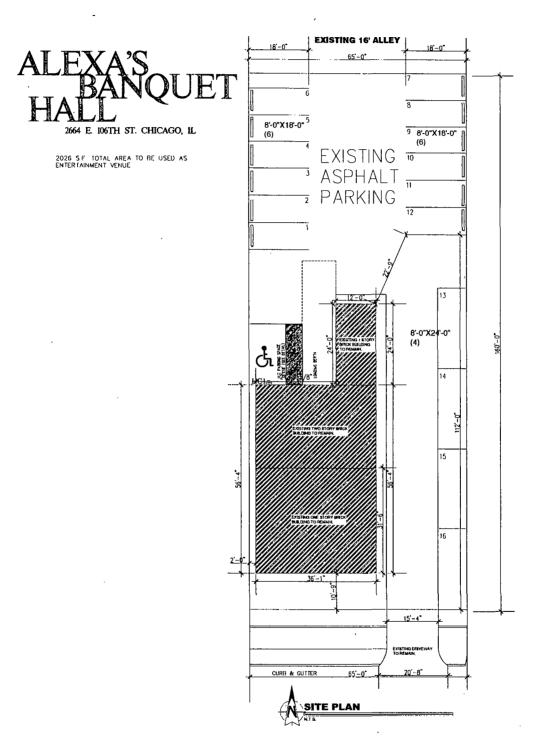
2026 S.F. TOTAL AREA TO BE USED AS ENTERTAINMENT VENUE



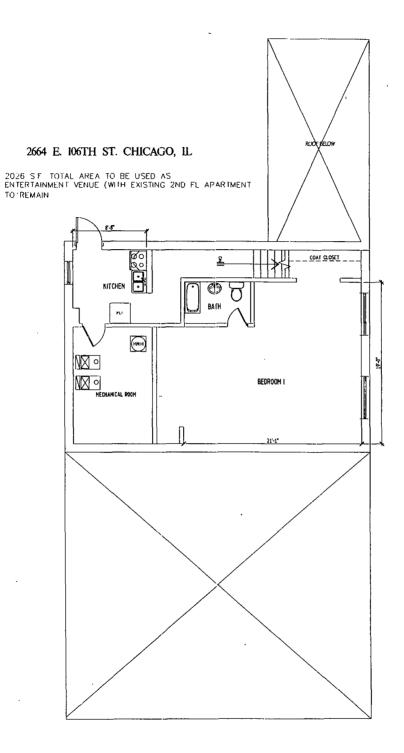

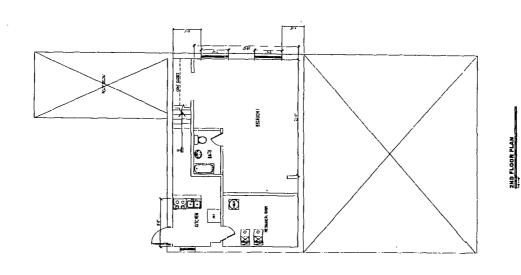
TOTAL OCCUPANCY 112 - DINING AREA

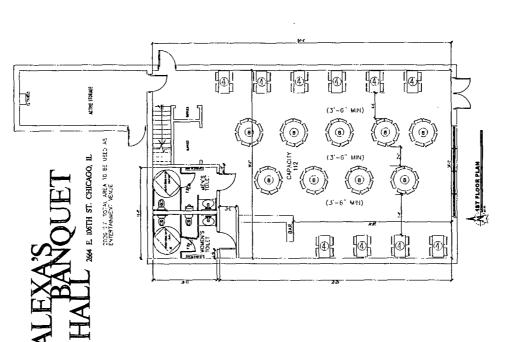

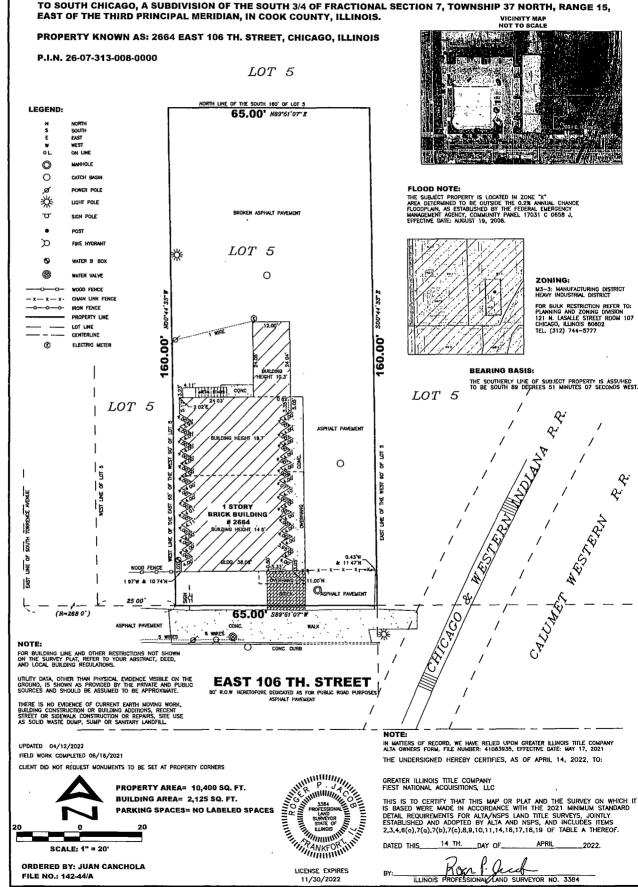
