BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Title 9, Chapter 64, of the Municipal Code of Chicago, that the Commissioner of Transportation is hereby authorized and directed to erect and/or amend Traffic Warning Signs and Signals, for the following locations are hereby designated:

22	South Millard Avenue and West 32nd Street; Three Way Stop Sign Stopping All Approaches {O2021-5676}
22	West 32nd Street and South Springfield Avenue; All Way Stop Sign, Stopping All Approaches {O2021-5677}
39	North Cicero Avenue (eastside), from North Forest Glen Avenue To West Peterson Avenue Also Add, North Cicero Avenue, (west side),From North Caldwell Avenue South Leg to North Caldwell Avenue North Leg; No Parking Of Semi-Trucks Tow Zone (Public) 22-00965584 [O2022-1739]
40	North California Avenue and West Berwyn Avenue; All-Way Stop Stopping All Approaches (Public) 22-01011047 [O2022-1562]
