"BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF CHICAGO AS FOLLOWS:

Pursuant to the home rule powers of the City of Chicago under Article VII of the 1970 Illinois Constitution and Article 28 of the Illinois Election Code, the Chicago City Council by resolution submits to the electors of the City of Chicago the following question of public policy at the next regular election occurring not less than 78 days after the passage of this referendum resolution:

"Shall the people of Chicago protect the good name of Soldier Field – which is a war memorial dedicated to the memory of soldiers who fought for our American democracy – by prohibiting the Mayor, City Council, Park District, or any other governmental entity from attaching a corporate name to Soldier Field or selling the naming rights to Soldier Field in any way?"
