

ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

Section 1. Pursuant to Section 2-8-040 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, which allows erection of honorary street name designations, the Commissioner of the Chicago Department of Transportation shall take the necessary action for standardization of South Kedzie Avenue, between South 77th Street and West Columbus Avenue as "Honorary Pastor Gicele Wray-Lindley, Way."

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication.

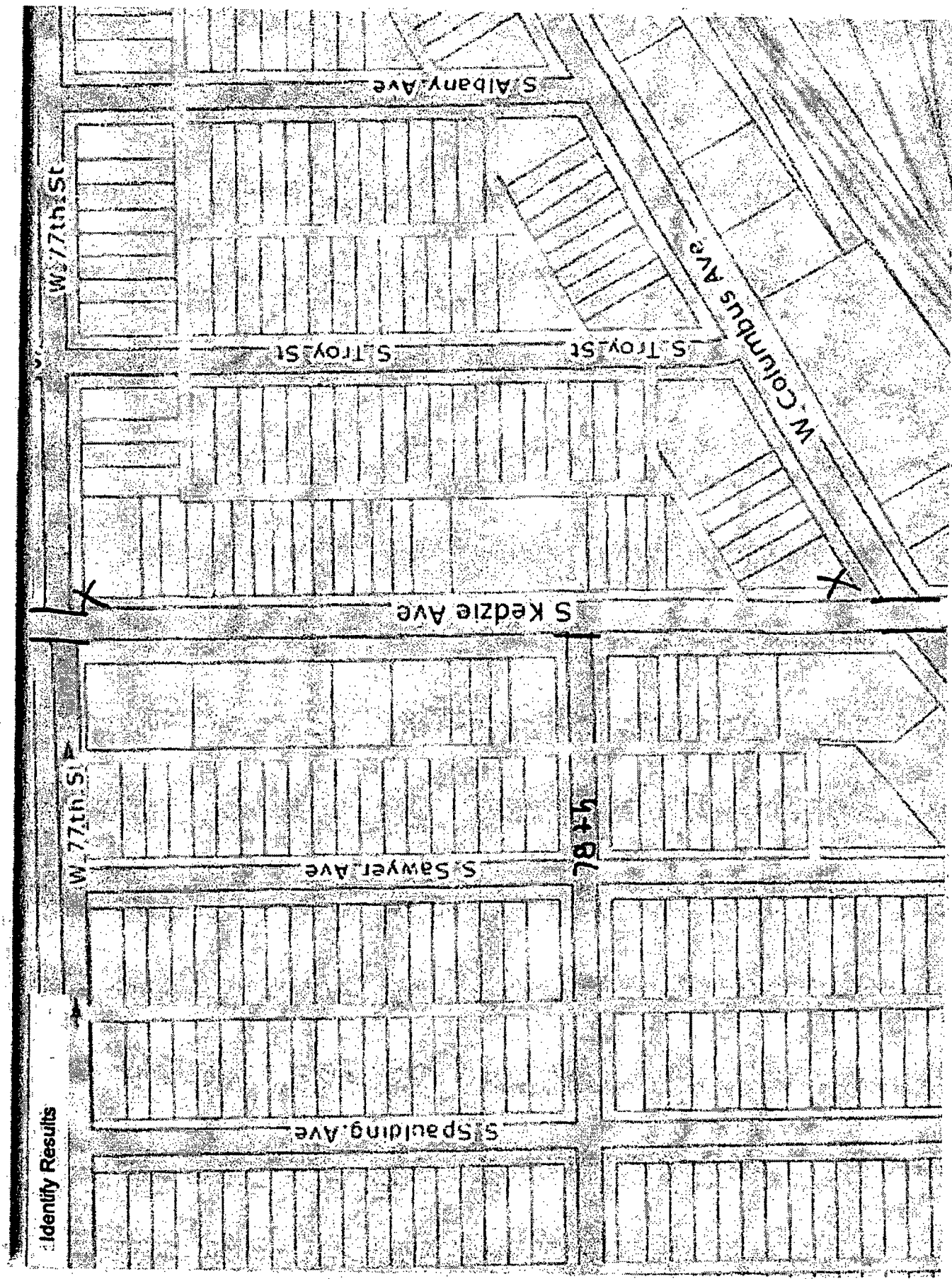

God has allowed Pastor Gicele to travel with her husband Omar in recent years to minister in several Latin American countries including (Costa Rica, Peru, Paraguay, Nicaragua, Guatemala, Panama, and Argentina). Gicele and Omar have also traveled and ministered in Brazil, the African Continent and in several US states.
