

**WHEREAS**, A truly exemplary human being, Mrs. Green will always be remembered for her selfless dedication to public service, her many contributions to the City of Chicago, and for her decency, strength of character, and faith; and

**WHEREAS**, Mrs. Green is survived by her husband of forty-nine years, G. Patrick Green; her daughter, Susan; her grandchildren, Michael and Timothy Pistilion; her brothers-and sisters-in-law, Charies and Margaret Green, Bill and Dorothy Green, Richard and Chariene Green, and Thomas Green, and a host of other family members and friends; now, therefore,
