BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO

SECTION 1. That an ordinance hereto passed by the City Council on December 12, 2007 on Journal page 17570, establishing a Standing Zone-Tow Zone Except with Flashing Lights, during specified hours on portions of designated streets be and the same is hereby amended to add three additional spaces by deleting the stricken through language and inserting the underlined from the following:

North Dayton Street (east side) from a point 5015 feet south of West Eastman Street, to a point 2560 feet east thereof – 15 minute standing zone – use flashing lights – a tow-away zone after 15 minutes – 7:30 A.M. to 5:304:30 P.M. – Monday through Friday (07-01834688)

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force upon its passage and publication.

### **15 MINUTE STANDING ZONE**

Please understand that:

- Vehicles parking in standing zones are limited to 15 minutes and must have their hazards tlashing while the driver is away from the vehicle.
- Vehicles extending their stay over the 15 minute time limit are in violation of the Chicago Municipal Code and are liable to receive a citation.
- Even though the standing zone is placed adjacent to your business, vehicles standing in the zone for the allotted time are not obligated to patronize your business.
- It is illegal to post additional signage in the public way, including signage, which would cause one to assert that the loading zone *is* reserved solely for your business.


Alderman Scott Waguespack:



CHALK Preschool is a half day preschool where we serve children ages 2-5 years old. We are applying for a 15 minute standing zone for the morning hours of 8:15-12:30 in front of the Preschool. We currently have a standing zone but do find since we are the only business that has a standing zone from 8:30-4:30 we have many other people also using the area which makes it difficult at the drop off and pick up times. We are in the same building as Tomato Head as well as Pump it Up and there are many other businesses in the area that also use the standing zone.
