

Pursuant to Section 11-12-540 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Commissioner of Water and the Commissioner of Sewers are hereby authorized and directed to cancel the assessments in the amount of \$521.55 charged to the Good Hope Freewill Baptist Church for the premises at 525 South California a/c # 290888.
